

MINUTES  
CALLED MEETING  
SEPTEMBER 22, 2009

The Monroe County Board of Commissioners met in a called session September 22, 2009 at 6:30 pm with the Mayor and the City of Forsyth Council. Present representing the County Commission were Chairman James Vaughn, Vice Chairman Jim Peters, Commissioner Larry Evans, Commissioner Mike Bilderback, Commissioner Jim Ham and County Administrator Anita Buice. Present representing the City of Forsyth were Mayor Tye Howard, Councilman Melvin Lawrence, Councilman Lamar Russell, City Manager Greg Popham and City Clerk Janice Hall.

Mayor Howard addressed the group with an update on the relocation of the Georgia Department of Corrections to Forsyth, the James Street CDBG project, StreetScape, the tax digest and Taste of Monroe.

Chairman Vaughn gave an update on the county's plan for a new administration building. Commissioner Evans explained the working partnership between Monroe County and Workforce Development to provide help to job seekers.

Mick Ashmore, Library Board member, addressed the Board and the Council reminding them that the Library is at capacity and will also need expansion soon.
