

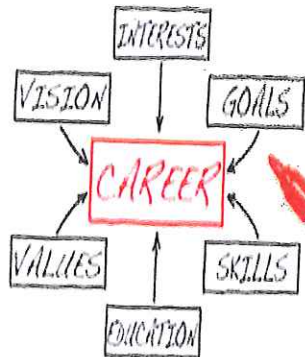
## About Us
